PE, SPORT AND HOUSE SPORT EVENTS AUTHORISATION FORM**

Dear Parent/ Guardian

1. PE Sport – Shenley Park:

As part of the College program from Years 7 to 12, your child will participate in a variety of class activities, such as PE Activities, which may include the use of Shenley Park, Avenue Athol, Canterbury. Students will walk to and from the venue in class groups with teacher supervision.

2. Sport Education (Years 7 and 8):

As part of the Sport Education program, students may undertake activities at local off campus venues. Details will be provided once students have been allocated to Sport Education classes.

3. House Sport Events:

The House sport program that your child participates in at Canterbury Girls' Secondary College consists of three activities that we hold each year. All students are encouraged and expected to participate in these events.

- Term 1 House Swimming Carnival – Boroondara Leisure Centre, Belmore Road, North Balwyn
- Term 2 House Cross Country – Shenley Park. Girls will walk to and from the venue in class groups
- House Athletics Carnival – Hagenauer Reserve, Barwon Street, Box Hill North

Further detailed information for each activity will be provided closer to the event.

Buses will be provided to take students to and from the venue for the swimming and athletics carnivals. However, students may make their own way to and from the venue. Students may be dismissed early from the venue but not before 2.30pm. Students will walk to the Cross-country venue.

Students must return the completed authorisation form before they are allowed to attend the off campus PE, Sport and House Sport Events. Please sign and return the form below to the General Office.
